5/26: Have a discussion with your child about what

it means to grow up. We get older, smarter,

bigger, and stronger. Have some fun, and go

through old photos with your child. If you have

photos at home, show your child photos of yourself when you were their age, and

compare it to a photo of them!

**5/27: Growing up means being responsible! Talk to your child about what it means to be responsible. Being responsible is something that you have a duty to do, and something that you're expected to get done. Talk to your child about the importance of clean up time, and have them help you do a chore at home in order to instill a sense of responsibility for helping around the house! Have your child draw a picture of clean up time.**

5/28: Growing up means learning to take care of yourself. Discuss the word "hygiene" with your child, and what it means to have good hygiene. (Taking a bath, brushing hair, brushing teeth, washing your face, washing your hands, and wearing clean clothes, etc.) Have your child watch these videos about healthy habits, and brushing their teeth! When you are done, help your child make a tooth name-plate (one letter per tooth).



Creecer significa aprender a cuidarte. Discuta la palabra "higiene" con su hijo y lo que significa tener una buena higiene. Cuando termine, ayude a su hijo a hacer una placa con el nombre con dientes (una letra por diente).
