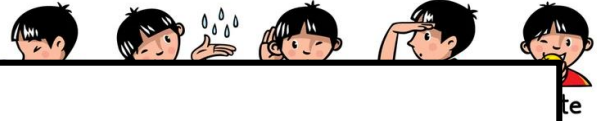


Ms. Johana's Weekly News
